Only PCR tests will be accepted. You will be tested again upon arrival. You may need to demonstrate you have such a test certificate before boarding your flight. All other passengers will be subject to 7 days mandatory quarantine, at government designated hotels. You may choose from a range of hotels at different prices, but cannot change hotel once your quarantine has started. Passengers are responsible for the full cost of their stay in quarantine. You may need to demonstrate that you have made a hotel booking for your quarantine before boarding your flight. During quarantine you will be tested for coronavirus. If you test negative you will be required to self-isolate at home for a further 7 days. If you test positive you may need to stay in quarantine or an isolation centre until you have recovered and tested negative. TRANSFER PASSENGERS- no quarantine required if your flight transfer is LESS than 8 hours. Remain in the airport. For transits over 8 hours, you will be taken to a designated transit hotel for the duration of your stay

These individuals will be exempt quarantine and are listed in the link under this table on the ATTA website. Otherwise, a 14 day quarantine will be required. All travellers will be screened on arrival and required to quarantine if they display symptoms of Covid-19 for 14 days..

Links to the HTA and full information on the arrival details can be found on the ATTA website: News & Alerts - COVID-19 - Useful COVID-19 links - From 1st October a new Visitor Travel Advisory has been implemented for the 7 countries with Special Status (UK, France, Germany, Italy, Switzerland, Austria and UAE) they will still be allowed to travel but with more stringent sanitary measures. - A negative PCR test certificate from an accredited or Government certified laboratory within 48 hours prior to departure to Seychelles must be submitted. - After landing, visitors will have their temperature taken and have symptoms checked whilst their certificates are reviewed. - After arrival into Seychelles, the visitor must stay in a designated establishment and many not leave the premises for 5 days. A repeat PCR test will be performed on the 5th day. If the test result is negative, the visitor will be free to continue with his/her planned holiday. If the result is positive, the visitor will be required to stay in a designated stay-safe hotel until cleared by the Public Health Authority.
